



Garbage Collection

Katherine Town Council provides a waste collection service to most residents within the Katherine Municipality.

A durable 240 litre mobile wheelie bin for properties is provided by the Council's contractor, CLEANAWAY. The bin remains the property of CLEANAWAY and must be left on the premises when vacated.

The property owner is charged a waste management fee. This fee covers the cost of a weekly rubbish removal service and the general householder use of the Waste Management Facility.

On Bin Day

Please place your bins as close as possible to the edge of the road and ensure the bin faces the road. Also ensure the bin is clear of obstructions such as trees, parked cars, power poles or fire hydrants.

Residents of some unit complexes area able to store their bins in special areas provided for bin storage.

All meat, fish, dairy products, vegetable and fruit scraps should be wrapped in old newspaper and placed in the wheelie bin.

Council Recommends that you put out bins the night before collection day.

Wednesday:	Victoria Highway, Katherine South, Zimin Drive, Stuart Estate, Emungalan Road, Gorge Road, North Side of Stuart Highway
Thursday:	Katherine East
Friday:	Collins Road, Byers Road, Uralla Road, Landsdowne Rd South side of Stuart Highway, Binjari

DO NOT

Overfill your bin so the lid does not close

Leave any rubbish beside the bin as it will not be collected.

Put hot ashes, sharp or heavy objects in your bin as they may damage it.



It is your responsibility to maintain your bin in a hygienic condition and it is advisable to hose it out regularly.

Recycling

Katherine Town Council offers a variety of recycling at the Waste Management Station located 5 kms west of Katherine off the Victoria Highway.

A waste oil facility is provided at the Waste Management Station and the oil is recycled.

Old cars, batteries, white goods and bulk steel are stockpiled at the Waste Management Station for collection by recyclers.

A scrap metal merchant is located on Bovril Street off the Victoria Highway and recycles aluminum cans, batteries, brass, copper, car radiators and steel.
