**4. BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES**

**4.1 Katherine Tennis Club - Shading:**

Council advised that Katherine Canvas & Upholstering are in the process of preparing plans.

Tennis Club confirmed that they have received the plans (grandstand shading) and will forward these to Council.

**4.2 Katherine Tennis Club - Road Signage:**
