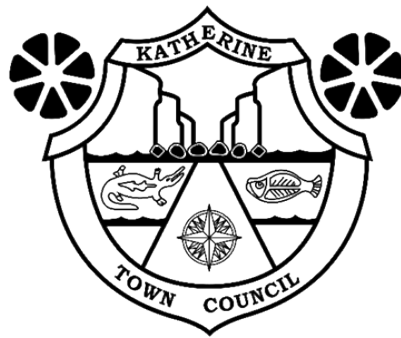

Officer Recommendation

The purpose of the report is to provide committee members with a proposed event concept for the Centenary of Katherine 2026 event and seek committee members further feedback.

Background

The town of Katherine will celebrate its 100th birthday on 1 July 2026. This will mark 100 years since the original declaration of the town.

With the establishment of the Centenary of Katherine 2026 Advisory Committee, initial feedback has been sort from committee members as to what this celebration may look like. An event concept has been developed by Council Officers for the Committees review and discussion.

Discussion

With the first formal meeting of the Advisory Committee in October 2023, members provided ideas and concepts as to what the commemorations may look like, summarised below:

- Historical recognition projects:
 - Murals
 - Plaques
 - Commemorative walk

- Greening initiatives
- Artistic exhibitions
- Feature infrastructure such as 'Welcome' statement and/or statue
- Large scale community events
- Strong recognition on Katherine's indigenous history
- Inclusion of Multicultural community
- Inclusion of RAAF community and history
- Events to occur over an extended period – potentially the entire year.

As a result of these discussions, Council Officers have constructed the initial event concept, combining common themes, leveraging existing events and proposing large standalone events that offer engagement through all sections of our target audience.

The event concept document is to provide the committee with an initial platform to commence further discussions and provide clearer recommendations as to the committee's aspirations for this event. Further, subject to approval by Council, event funding streams can be identified, and discussion can commence with potential community partners and/or stakeholders.

This report was developed as a result of consultation with the Centenary of Katherine 2026 Advisory Committee.

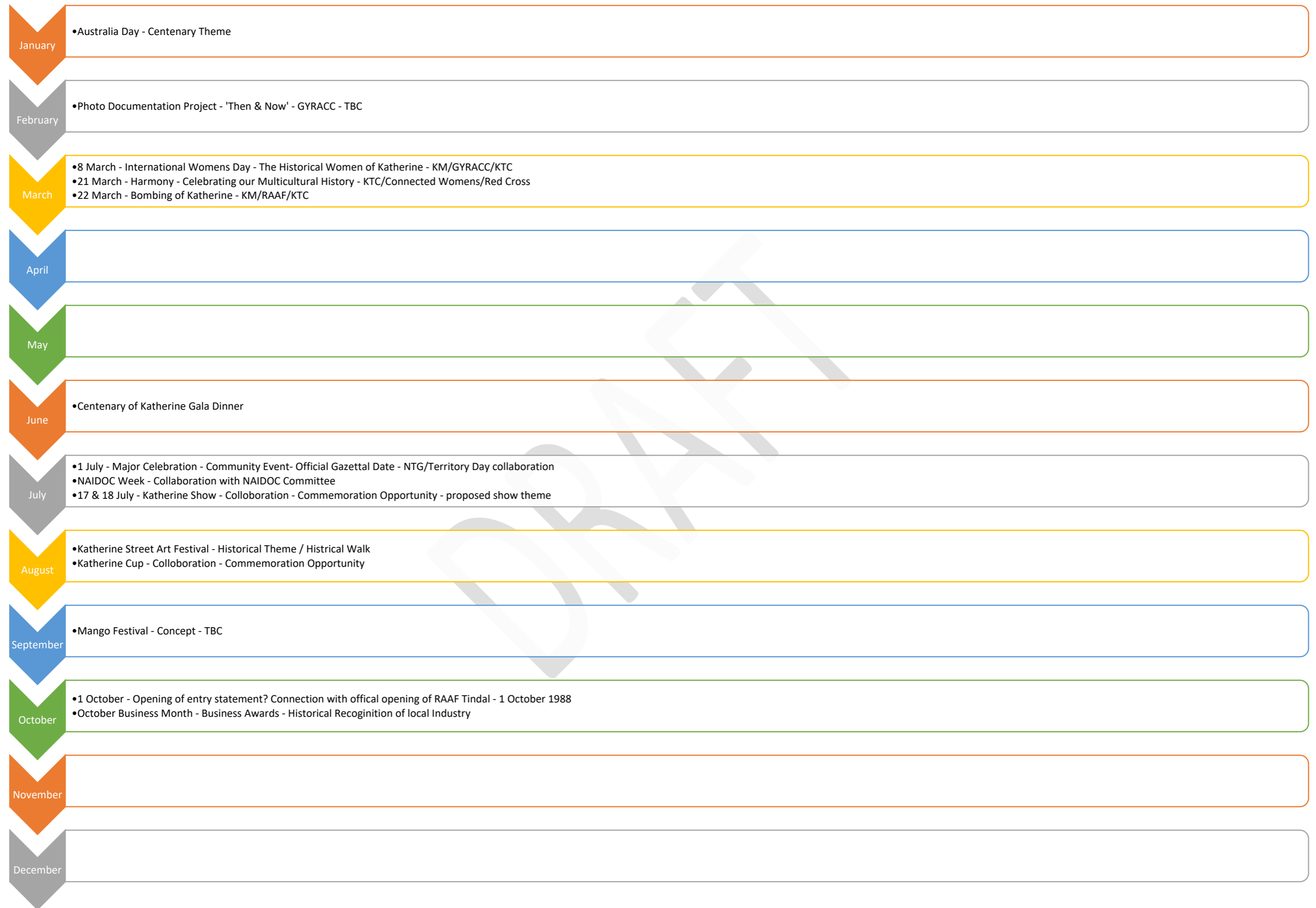
